Fanti Baum

Fanit Baum lives and works an artist and theoretician in Dortmund and Frankfurt. She works between the arts in a variety of collaborations and develops performances, installations, dance pieces and site-specific works. Recently, together with Frédéric De Carlo, Joana Tischkau, René Alejandro Huari Mateus and Zwoisy Mears-Clarke, she presented the dance piece Hors de Combat at Frankfurt LAB and during the festival Land/Horses: "the feel of the horses long before horses enter the scene" which was implanted in Frankfurt in the now-demolished horse racing grounds. Fanit Baum is a member of the performance group Arty Chock, whose work was recently seen at Lichter Filmfestival and at MMK Frankfurt. As a dramaturg, she has worked, amongst others, for dasTheater Winkelwiese in Zurich, for the exhibition and performance project Demonstrations. Vom Werden normativer Ordnungen in Frankfurt Kunstverein, for the production Josefine in Fonds experimentelles Musiktheater NRW and with Claudia Bosse in Tanzquartier Wien in Vienna. She received the artistic project grant FORMAT from Thalia Theater Halle, traveled with a grant from the Goethe-Institut to Egypt and developed the work to be policed: how police moves our body there with the flausen grant.

In 2018, she directed the Favoriten Festival in Dortmund together with Oliva Ebert; she placed a special focus on an understanding of the political as a form, aesthetic and in specific artistic working methods. In 2019, she is working as an academic associate at Goethe University Frankfurt and is a fellow at Akademie Schloss Solitude.
